Costs of university

There are a range of costs associated with attending university, for example:

- ❖ Tuition fees
- ❖ Living costs
- ❖ Study materials and supplies
- ❖ Additional course fees – for other services provided by the university

Strategies to help pay for university

There are a range of government scholarships, supports and other strategies enabling you to study at university.

Government Support

Research the government financial support you're eligible for at studyassist.gov.au

For example:

- ❖ **Most Australian residents** will be eligible for financial support, allowing students to pay their tuition fees with a government loan.
- ❖ **Regional and rural students** are likely to be eligible for support with the start-up and relocation costs associated with studying away from home.

Private Scholarships

Many private organisations provide student scholarships for general or specific areas of study.

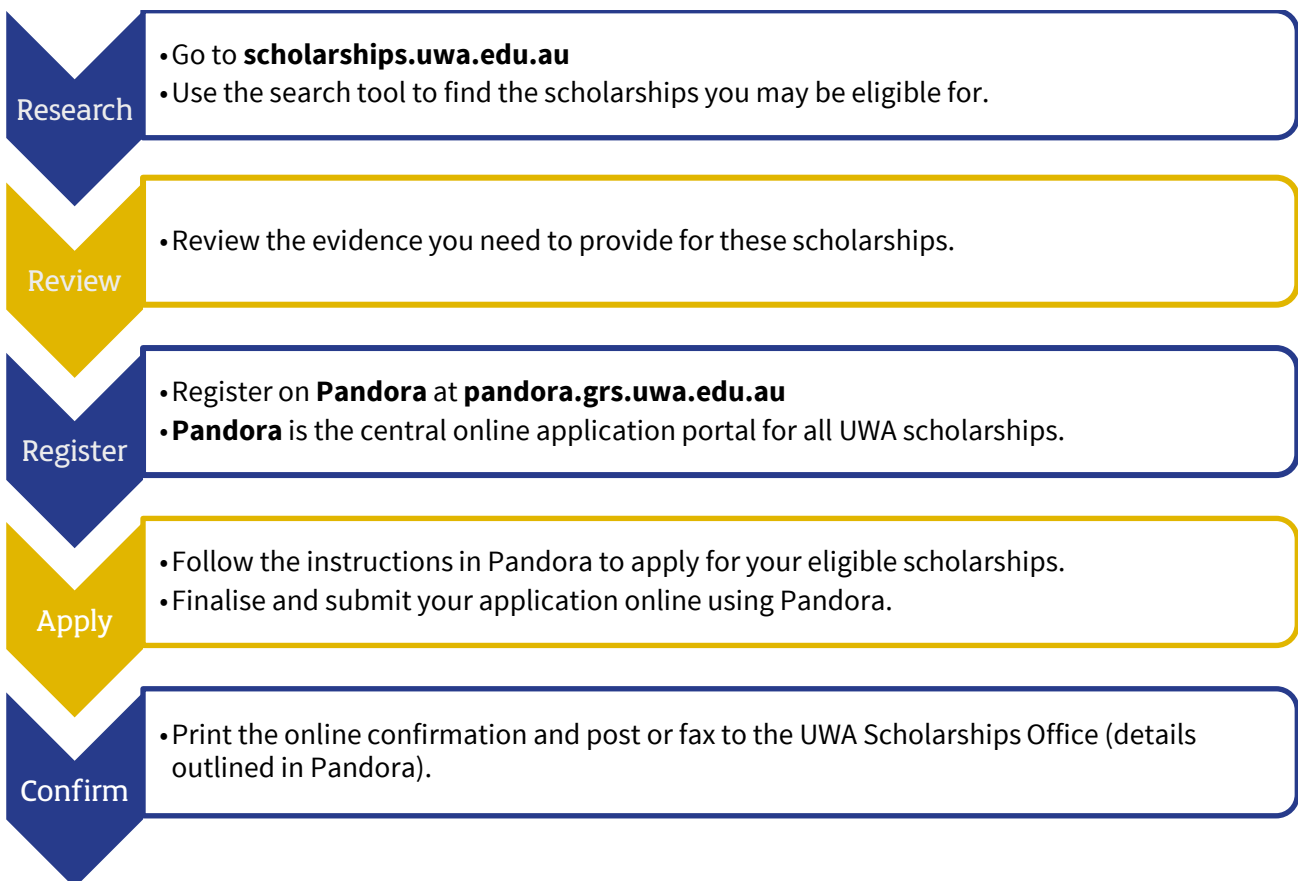
UWA Scholarships
