

iPad Purchasing and Hire Options for BYOD Programme

The College is pleased to offer the following options for families whose child requires the use of an iPad in 2020. 5th, 6th and 7th Generation iPads with at least 32GB of storage are suitable for use in the Middle School. Older iPads may still be used; however, they must support iOS 11 to ensure app compatibility.

1. Purchasing yourself through Winthrop Australia

2. Purchase Plan through College

Where families want to own, but pay over a ten month period. Responsibility for care and cost of repairs is with the purchasing family. Conditions may apply to be eligible. Protective cover is not included. Prices will vary and will be confirmed upon contract creation.

3. Hire Plan through College

Recommended where other options are not affordable and conditions may apply to be eligible. The iPad remains the property of the College and should the iPad be damaged and/or require repairs, families will be required to pay. A protective cover is included.

4. Borrowing Plan through College

Families in financial hardship or on a Fee Remission are eligible to apply. The iPad remains the property of the College and must be kept onsite at all times. The library is available for students to work on their iPads until 4.00pm

Under options 3 and 4 above, downloading and storage of personal files are not permitted. Should the iPad be damaged or not given appropriate care, the College may require the family to revert to Option 2. Where covers are not included above, it is the family's responsibility to make sure they purchase one.

The policies in relation to acceptable use of iPads continue to apply and families should contact the appropriate Head of School if they're not already aware of these policies.

Families may contact Mr Miles Mitchell (IT Officer) should they wish to take up any of the above options or if they would like to check if an iPad they currently own will be suitable.
