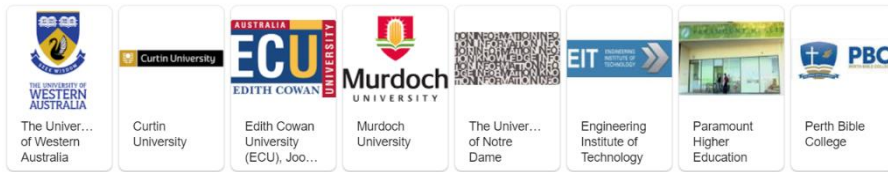

 - 18 students Y10 (Certificate II in Music Industry) Auspiced with MPC
 - 7 students Y11 (Certificate III in Music Industry) Auspiced with MPC
 - 14 students Y12 (Certificate III in Sound Production) auspiced with MPC
 - 7 students Y12 (Certificate II in Visual Arts) Auspiced with North Metropolitan TAFE
 - 9 students Y11/12 (VET in schools studying off campus at either NM TAFE or SM TAFE)
 - 14 students Y11/12 (Studying Nationally Accredited online qualifications)



Update from AISWA - ADWPL & Work Experience students 2020, advise from Department of Education & Australian Health Protection Principal Committee (AHPPC).
